Resubmitted Application vs. Re-exam Application – What's the difference?

Resubmitted Application:

- A resubmitted application is needed when a coordinator at PCS informs you that there is an error on your original application.
- There is an FAQ Help Page <u>here</u> that will guide through the application resubmission process.

Re-exam Application

- A re-exam application is needed when you already have an existing application with PCS (started within one year), have taken the NCLEX, and failed the examination.
- To start a re-exam application, complete the following steps:
