INTRODUCTION

The Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection has contracted with Engineering Examination Services (EES), a division of Professional Credential Services, for examination scheduling, administration, and score reporting for the engineering and surveyor examinations. Please read the following information carefully before continuing with on-line scheduling. REGISTRATION & SCHEDULING INFORMATION:

First-Time Candidates: Applicant's who have NEVER APPLIED TO OR RECEIVED APPROVAL FROM the Connecticut Board

1. All applicants must APPLY TO AND RECEIVE APPROVAL FROM the Connecticut Board. First-time applicants must contact the Board for application information. IF APPLIED AND APPROVED proceed to step 2.
2. All applicants create an account online with NCEES if you have not already done so. You may create an account 365 days a year at the NCEES' website (REMEMBER; CREATING AN

ACCOUNT DOES NOT MEAN YOU HAVE REGISTERED FOR THE EXAMINATION WITH NCEES). To complete registration you will need to log back into your account during specified times for each examination cycle). Proceed to step 3.

3. Register online with NCEES by the registration deadline (DEADLINE ENFORCED, NO EXCEPTIONS). Select your exam type, and site information at this time. Only Board-Approved applicants proceed to step 4.
4. Board-Approved applicants must schedule and pay the examination fee with PCS/EES by the scheduling deadline (NO LATE REQUEST, NO EXCEPTIONS).

Reexamination Candidates: Applicant's who have already received approval from the Connecticut Board for the examination type they are requesting.

1. All applicants create an account online with NCEES if you have not already done so. You may create an account 365 days a year at the NCEES website. If you have already created an account with NCEES, proceed to step 2.

Each time an applicant plans to sit for the examination, they MUST:

2. Register online with NCEES by the registration deadline, YES, EVEN IF YOU HAVE ALREADY CREATED AN ACCOUNT AND REGISTERED DURING ANOTHER EXAMINATION CYCLE. Select your exam type, and site information at this time. Proceed to step 3.
3. Board-approved applicants must schedule and pay the examination fee with EES/PCS by the scheduling deadline (NO LATE REQUEST, NO EXCEPTIONS).

The refunds given to candidates will be less a processing fee of \$50.00 and will not be processed until 30 to 45 days after the examination.
