INTRODUCTION

The Board of Examiners of Engineers, Architects, and Surveyors of Puerto Rico has engaged Engineering Examination Services (EES) for application processing, examination administration, and grade reporting. Please read the following information carefully before completing the enclosed application form. All inquiries regarding the examination must be directed to the Puerto Rico Coordinator at Engineering Examination Services. Applicants should not contact the Board office except regarding certification and licensure.

ALL CANDIDATES ARE REQUIRED TO CREATE AN ACCOUNT AND REGISTER WITH NCEES AT WWW.NCEES.ORG. YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO SCHEDULE AND PAY FOR THE EXAM WITH EES WITHOUT DOING SO. YOU MUST REGISTER INTO YOUR ACCOUNT FOR EVERY EXAM CYCLE.

Exam types/disciplines **CAN NOT** be changed after the NCEES registration deadline, no exceptions. Your exam selection on your NCEES account will dictate the examination booklet ordered for you. To change your selection *before* the NCEES registration deadline, you must 1) log into your NCEES account and change your selection and 2) send an email to preng@pcshq.com with your new selection.

All FE candidates will be asked to specify which afternoon module they wish to take at the time of registration. Visit www.ncees.org for your options.

Civil, Electrical and Mechanical PE applicants will be required to specify their afternoon design standards at the time of registration. Visit www.ncees.org for your options

FILING APPLICATIONS (*First-time*)

The same application form is provided for the following examinations: 1) Fundamentals of Engineering (FE); 2) Principles & Practice of Engineering (PE); 3) Fundamentals of Surveying (FS); and 4) Principles & Practice of Surveying (PS). Be certain to indicate on the enclosed application for which examination you are an applicant.

First-time applicants are those who:

- have not completed an application with EES as a Puerto Rico candidate; or
- have not taken the examination since October, 1998 as a Puerto Rico candidate; or
- have previously taken the examination for another jurisdiction.

Completed applications must be received by Engineering Examination Services by January 31st for the April 2011 examination and July 15th for the October 2011 examination. Educational documentation must be received no later than February 18th for the April 2011 exam and no later than September 9th for the October 2011 exam. Applications will not be accepted after the deadline for any reason.

FILING APPLICATIONS (*Re-exam*)

To schedule and pay over the internet, please visit our web site, www.pcshq.com, between January 14th and February 18th for the April 2011 examination and between August 1st and September 9th for the October 2011 examination. To schedule and pay over the telephone, please call 877-ENG-EXAM (877-364-3926) between January 14th and February 18th for the April 2011 examination and between August 1st and September 9th for the October 2011 examination. You are a re-examine candidate **only** if you have taken an examination with Engineering Examination Services since October 1998.

VERIFICATION OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATION

First-Time candidates Do NOT contact Engineering Examination Services to verify receipt of your application. Send your application certified mail, return receipt requested or express mail, return receipt requested.

Re-exam candidates that schedule and pay over the internet or telephone will receive a confirmation notice within 14 business days.

PE STRUCTURAL APPLICANTS:

The 16 hour PE Structural exam will be offered for the first time in April 2011. It is a breadth and depth exam offered in two components on successive days. The 8-hour Vertical Forces (Gravity/Other) and Incidental Lateral component is offered only on Friday and focuses on gravity loads and lateral earth pressures. The 8-hour Lateral Forces (Wind/Earthquake) component is offered only on Saturday and focuses on wind/earthquake loads. Candidates must receive an acceptable result on both components within a 5-year period. For more information, please visit www.ncees.org.

First-Time candidates payment must be by certified check or U.S. money order (NO personal checks) made payable to Engineering Examination Services/PR ENG. The applicant's social security number must be posted on the certified check or money order.

Re-exam candidates may schedule over the internet or telephone with a VISA or MasterCard. The acceptable form of payment if you requested an invoice during your telephone registration is a certified check or U.S. money order (NO personal checks).

VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION VOUCHERS ARE NOT ACCEPTED FOR PAYMENT OF EXAMINATION FEES. FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED OR TRANSFERRED TO FUTURE EXAMINATIONS FOR ANY REASON. NO EXCEPTIONS.

ELIGIBILITY FOR EXAMINATION

In order to qualify for the examination, applicants must:

- be of good moral character; and
- be a U.S. citizen or legal resident of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico; and
- have a baccalaureate degree in science from an accredited U.S. academic institution and completed an engineering program that is recognized by the Higher Education Council of Puerto Rico or by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET).

Puerto Rico does NOT accept Technology degrees of any kind.

FOREIGN EDUCATION: Applicants who received their bachelor's degree from a school outside of the United States and want to qualify based on education, MUST have their education credentials evaluated by the NCEES CREDENTIAL EVALUATIONS or JOSEF SILNY & ASSOCIATES, INC. The original evaluation must be mailed or emailed directly to EES from the evaluation company. The candidate must ensure everything is mailed to Engineering Examination Services by the entry deadline.

EVIDENCE OF QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants who are in their last term of enrollment in a baccalaureate degree program must arrange to have the enclosed Certificate of Enrollment (COE) indicating work in progress completed by the Registrar. The COE must be returned by the application deadline. Official academic transcripts (only if degree has been conferred on transcript) must be submitted directly to Engineering Examination Services from the institution.

Applicants who have completed coursework and have not received the diploma may submit an official Certificate of Completion (COC) verifying the course completion and baccalaureate degree conferral. After graduation, the applicant must arrange for final transcripts to be mailed directly from their academic institution to Engineering Examination Services after the degree has been posted.

Official evidence that the educational requirements have been met must be received for the completion of your file and for release of scores.

MATERIALS TO BE SUBMITTED

All applicants must submit the following materials by the application deadline:

1. Completed, signed and notarized application with a "2x2" photograph attached;
2. Certified check or U.S. money order made payable to EES for examination fees. Please record the social security number on the certified check or money order;
3. Certificates of Good Moral Character completed by three references that are licensed professional engineers/surveyors in good standing. (License cannot be expired).
4. Certificate of Enrollment (if currently enrolled) or Certificate of Completion (if degree is not conferred on transcripts); or Official transcripts (with degree conferred); issued directly from the academic institution to EES – due by February 18th for the April 2011 exam and September 9th for the October 2011 exam.

NCEES

All applicants are required to create an account and register with NCEES before scheduling and paying for the exam with PCS. If you have already created an account, you MUST register by logging back into your account at www.ncees.org for each exam cycle you sit for.

Candidates must visit the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying web site (www.ncees.org) to register. Candidates are also encouraged to visit the website for the latest information on calculators. Pennsylvania will strictly adhere to the NCEES recommendations/guidelines regarding the calculator policy. NCEES also lists the exam dates for the next 10 years.

EXAMINATION RULES AND CONDUCT

Candidates are expected to exhibit proper examination decorum throughout the examination. Candidates will be required to arrive at least thirty minutes prior to the scheduled time for each examination section. **Candidates will not be admitted to the examination after the announcements have been given for that examination section.** Detailed instructions concerning arrival will be included with the admission ticket. Only bound reference books will be allowed in the examination room during the PE and PS examinations. During the FE examination, only the NCEES-supplied Reference Handbook will be permitted in the examination room. The Reference Handbook will be distributed to candidates on examination day. Candidates may request a copy of the Reference Handbook prior to the examination by contacting NCEES (1-800-250-3196) or may download and print the materials from the NCEES web site (www.ncees.org).

ENGLISH NOTE

Instructions at the examination are given in Spanish at the Puerto Rico examination site. If you do not understand Spanish please contact EES immediately so that English announcements can be provided for you.

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS

In accordance with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), examination administration modifications are available for candidates who qualify. Also, candidates who are members of religious faiths that cannot take the examination on the designated date are permitted to take the examination on the Monday, following the national examination date. Please go to the NCEES web site (www.ncees.org) to read complete information as to the application procedures for special accommodations.

ALL REQUESTS AND DOCUMENTATION ARE DUE BY THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE.

Please note that the mailing addresses for the requests vary by the type of request you are making. The correct mailing address is on each specific report.

NOTIFICATION OF EXAMINATION ADMISSION

Applicants must allow four weeks for full processing of their examination application. Approximately two weeks prior to the examination, an exam authorization will be mailed to eligible candidates and will include dates, times, and location of the examination. If the exam authorization has not been received within seven days prior to the examination date, the candidate must contact Engineering Examination Services.

NAME OR ADDRESS CHANGES

Any name or address change must be reported in writing to Engineering Examination Services. Be sure to include your name as it appears on your application and your social security number, and copies of any court documents if applicable. Name or address changes may be emailed to EES at preng@pcshq.com. Candidates must also notify the Board of any name or address change.

RESULTS

Results are mailed to the address on file for candidates approximately 10 to 12 weeks after the examination. Candidates do not receive numeric scores for the FE/PE/FS/PS examinations. Results will not be given over the phone, or through email. Please do not call either the Puerto Rico Board Office or EES for test results.

SCORE VERIFICATIONS

Score verifications will be available on our web site for a limited time. A nominal fee will be charged for this service. Visit our web site for additional information about score verifications.

EES CONTACT INFORMATION

Engineering Examination Services staff is available by telephone Monday through Friday between 7:00 am and 4:30 pm, central time. Applications must be submitted by regular mail or by express mail of the U.S. Post Office. Deliveries from express services other than the U.S. Postal Service cannot be accepted in a post office box. If you are using another express service, please use the courier address. If you want verification of receipt of your application, send it certified mail, return receipt requested. **DO NOT CONTACT ENGINEERING EXAMINATION SERVICES TO VERIFY RECEIPT OF YOUR APPLICATION.**
